The Curriculum

English

In English, the children will learn how to write their own historical narrative by exploring the vocabulary and features from the text 'Escape from Pompeii'. The children will use expanded noun phrases to describe characters and setting. They will use their history knowledge to support them with this. In the next unit children will write a set of instructions on how to build a Roman road.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths the children will be consolidating their Year 3 work on the place value of numbers up to 1000 before moving onto representing and portioning numbers to 10,000. Children will be positioning numbers on a number line and finding more and less than a given number. Children will estimate, order, and compare numbers up to 10,000 before rounding numbers and writing some roman numerals.

Other Curriculum Subjects.

In **Science** the children will be learning how sound travels through the ear and completing some investigations.

In History the children will be learning about the Romans changed Britain.

In R.E the children will learn why Jesus was an inspiration leader

In **computing** they will be learning how to keep themselves safe online by using the SMART rules. Then they will learn how to search online for different information.

In **DT** children will be tasting different dips and dippers and learning how to chop an onion in preparation for making their own dip.

This half term in **music** we will be studying a piece of music by Henry Purcell to help develop our listening skills as well as using this piece of music to create our own variation to perform as a class ensemble.

In P.E the children will be learning how to play hockey, rugby, football and basketball.

Reading
