Winter plan to help most vulnerable



This winter, one in five people are expected not to be able to heat their homes properly, and one in 20 will not have enough food.

Vulnerable people, such as those with disabilities or health conditions, are disproportionately affected. The cost-of-living crisis is one of the reasons that MKCC have a surge in demand for their services, so for the second year they are committing funding to help residents facing food and energy insecurity.

They are doing this to support residents, but also to try to prevent some of the pressure on essential services such as hospitals. The MKCC Winter Plan was received by Cabinet last week. Find it here alongside useful links to services and support.
