# The Curriculum

#### **English**

In English, the children will be using their knowledge from last half term when they study the narrative The Wild Girl by looking at descriptive vocabulary, prepositions, conjunctions ready for them to write their own narratives. We will explore this text in our reading too. We will be exploring, performing, reading, and writing poetry too.

### Maths

In maths the children will be revisiting the times tables they have previously learnt 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10. We will then go on to learn the 6, 7, 9, 11 & 12 times tables and division facts through missing number tracks, counting and looking at work problems. We encourage children to practice their times tables at home on TTRS.

# Other Curriculum Subjects.

In Science the children will be learning about electricity and how to make a simple circuit, what makes a good conductor of electricity and how to use a switch in a circuit. In Geography the children will be using Google Maps to explore Milton Keynes and other areas of the UK to compare how they have changed over time.

In R.E the children will continue to learn about Jesus and why he is an inspirational leader.

In computing they will be learning how to make animations.

In Art the children will be learning how to draw people to scale.

In music the children will be learning about what instruments make up an orchestra. In P.E the children will learn how to play basketball, 4NB will be going swimming and their indoor PF is dance.

#### Things to remember.

Children come to school in their PE kits on their PE day.

If your child has a club after school, they must come to school in their uniform and bring their PE kit to change into unless it's their PE day.

#### Reading
