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Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that everybody had an enjoyable break over the Easter holidays. It is hard to believe that we are into the final term of this academic year, which apparently means we are in the summer term... although the weather would have us believe otherwise! We are eagerly awaiting a return to the field for break and lunchtimes but in the meantime, whilst the field continues to dry out, children are enjoying the use of the new outdoor classrooms. As the weather is so changeable, **please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat in school every day to enable them to be outside during social times**, and for PE lessons, at this time of year.

From next week, there will be some changes to the way PE is taught at EVS. **Mr Moloney** has decided to leave EVS after 10 years as a Sports Coach at our School. He will be sadly missed, but we wish him well in his new role working with older children. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr Moloney for his hard work across our Federation during his time with us, both in curriculum PE lessons and in extra curricular clubs and festivals. **Mr Bolesta**, will also be leaving EVS later on this term after almost 2 years.
