The Curriculum

<u>English-</u> We will start the term looking at poetry. Using Lewis Carrol's Jabberwocky as our stimulus, the children will be looking at nonsense poems. The children will then move onto discussion texts where they will be outlining different points of view.

<u>Maths-</u> This term will be looking at shape including translation of, angles, degrees and coordinates. We will then be returning to look at decimals- adding, comparing and multiplying by 10,100 etc <u>Science-</u> This half term's topic is properties and the changing of materials. Within this topic the children will be learning about why specific materials are used for different purposes. Comparing and grouping materials based on their properties. They will also be learning about reversible and irreversible changes.

<u>Geography-</u> This term we will looking at different mountains, comparing famous mountains, looking at fossils found and comparisons of Cumbrian mountains too.

<u>PSHE-</u> Our topic for this half term is centered around relationships and the different relationships between friends and how to resist the temptations that peer pressure can bring.

 $\underline{\text{RE}}\text{-}$ In RE we are looking at the teaching of humanism. Within this we look at role models, Einstein, Darwin and Alice Roberts.

<u>Computing-</u> In Computing we are working on our word processing skills.

<u>Art-</u> We will be looking at various, child friendly, Maya sculptures with the children creating their own out of clay.

<u>Music-</u> The children will be prasticing performance. This will focus on the musical stylings of the pop group ABBA. Parents will have the opportunity to watch these during the celebration of work on May 22^{nd}

<u>PE-</u> In PE this half term the children will be doing athletics and Outdoor Adventure Activities. In their other PE lesson they will be learning how to play tennis. Hopefully, the beginning of the next Raducanu or Murray.
