Summer holidays support

The Milton Keynes City Council Summer Activities and Food programme will be taking place from **Monday 29th July to Thursday 22nd August 2024** – providing over 24,200 free activity and food sessions for children, young people and their families who are **in receipt of benefit related Free School Meals.** The programme will go live on Monday **1st July** via the online booking system here. The Summer offer will take place in 61 locations across MK, including 10 locations with dedicated support for children with special educational needs and disabilities. Milton Keynes City Council KCC has administered the Household Support Fund providing supermarket vouchers during the school holidays for families eligible for benefit related free school meals, and families who are receiving Universal Credit and Working and Child Tax Credits. **As funds are now limited, they will only be able to offer 1 week of food vouchers from the Household Support Fund during the Summer holiday.**
