Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you had an enjoyable half term. As we head into the final half term of this academic year, there is lots happening across the Federation. During the next few weeks, we start to think ahead to the new year and plan transition activities for children to prepare them for the next part of their educational journey.

On **Monday 1st July, children in years 3, 4 and 5 will spend the day with their new class and Teacher.** On this day, children in Year 2 will also spend the day at Emerson Valley, meeting their new class and Teacher. On this day, most year 6 children will also spend the day at their new secondary school. If your child's Year 7 transition day is on a different day, they should attend school as normal on this day.

## Drop in for vaccinations



Our health partners have organised drop-in clinics for young children who aren't up to date with their vaccinations. Uptake levels for all childhood vaccinations – such as whooping cough, measles, and polio - have been falling over the past decade.
