RETURN TO SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2024

Here are a few useful reminders about uniform and expectations as we move in to the new school year. **Please make sure that all items are clearly named**. Please bear in mind the following when you are purchasing new school uniform for your child:

School Uniform	PE Kit
Trousers/skirts/pinafores—black or grey	Black sports shorts
White 'School style' shirts, blouses or polo shirts (with EVS logo or plain)	Jade EVS logo t-shirt
Years 3, 4 and 5: Burgundy sweatshirt or cardigan (with school logo / plain). Year 6: black sweatshirt or cardigan (with school logo / plain)	Trainers (not plimsolls)
Black tights / black or white sock	Plain black or navy tracksuit bottoms
Plain black school shoes or flat ankle boots	Plain black or navy sweatshirt

Hair: Children should not have shaved patterns in their hair. Shoulder length hair should be tied up for school

Jewellery:

Jewellery should be limited to one single stud earring in each ear (not hoops). These must be taped over or removed before school on PE days. A watch may be worn (but not a smart watch). No other jewellery, including bracelets and necklaces, should be worn to school.

PE: PE days for next half term are as follows

Year	Days
Year 3	Tuesday and Friday
Year 4	Tuesday and Wednesday
Year 5	Monday and Thursday
Year 6	Monday and Wednesday

All children should come in to school wearing their PE kit on their PE days.

From September, the following changes have been made at:

- Our wrap around care club will now operate until 6:00pm (instead of 5:45pm) on a trial basis for the autumn term. The cost for this session will be £11.50.
- Children are bringing more and more belongings to school and our classrooms are not big enough to accommodate the size of some pencil cases. From the start of the new term, all stationary will be provided by school. Children should not bring pencil cases to school.
- Following our review of the behaviour policy we will be introducing a new reward system
 to all children across the Federation at the start of the new term. More details to follow
 in September

Please remember that drop off is from 8:45-8:55am. The gates will shut promptly at 8:55am so please arrive on time. Collection is at 3:25pm.
