

Year 6 Autumn 1 - Homework Menu

Below is a table of homework activities for you to choose from each week. Over the half term you must complete a minimum of at <u>least one activity each week</u>. You may choose to complete all of the activities if you wish to do so. Any projects completed as part of the curriculum tasks can be brought into school the week of the **14**th **October** to be shared with your class and teacher.

As well as this, you will receive a maths and English task on SATs Companion each week. These tasks will be set to consolidate what you are learning in class that week and to get you into the habit of doing weekly homework in preparation for secondary school. These tasks will be set on a Monday and must be completed by 8:30a.m on the following Monday. Remember, the weekly tasks are written in your Reading Record for you to remember. Your first task will be set on Monday 16th September and due in on Monday 23rd September.

Don't forget, as part of your homework, you should also be practising the Statutory Spellings for Y3/4 and Y5/6 as well as practising your times tables.

Finally, please remember to read at home every night. Please tell us about the book you are reading by writing in your reading record. We would like to see at least 4 entries in your reading record weekly. We will check your reading records every Monday!

Curriculum Task 1 ENGLISH: Firework Maker's Daughter Create a poster advertising Lila as a firework maker. Include everything that you know about different types of fireworks.	Curriculum Task 2 GEOGRAPHY: Rising sea levels Create a poster or diagram explaining why sea levels are rising.	Curriculum Task 3 GEOGRAPHY: Greenhouse effect Make a 'shoebox model' or draw a diagram to show the greenhouse effect. Use images and labels to help explain how the greenhouse effect works.
