The Curriculum

English:

This term our English starts by finishing the unit on Cotton Rock the children started before half term. They then move onto writing a journal about being on Mars. Our last write of the half term will be a narrative based on The Snowman.

<u>Maths:</u>

Within Maths, we will initially be revisiting Multiplication and Division to consolidate our learning about multiples and factors. We will then be learning about fractions including: equivalent, improper and mixed number fractions. Year 5 will also be comparing fractions and adding or subtracting the different types of fractions.

<u>History:</u>

This half term's topic is the Ancient Greeks. We will be looking at some Greek myths, learning about Alexander the Great, learning about the Ancient Greek civilisation and then looking at how the Greeks have impacted upon our lives today.

<u>Science:</u>

Year 5 will be looking at forces this half term. During the half term the children will be learning about fraction, gravity, air resistance, water resistance and how we can make mechanisms to have an effect on forces.

<u>Music:</u>

This term's music the children will be continuing their work on the guitars. Learning how to play along with music.

PE:

This term's PE is Basketball and Dance. In basketball the children will be learning how to dribble, pass and shoot within the laws of the game. In dance children will be learning rhythm and movement.

<u>Computing:</u>

This half term the children will learning how to code in their computing lessons. Starting on the efficiency of coding all the way to learning how to create different coding strings. **PSHE:**

This term our PSHE topic is titled celebrating difference. Children will be exploring different cultures and how they differ. They are going to have an anti-bullying week and also look at economic differences across cultures.

DT:
