Below is a table of homework activities for you to choose from each week. Over the half term you must complete a minimum of at <u>least one activity each week</u>. You may choose to complete all of the activities if you wish to do so. Any projects completed as part of the curriculum tasks can be brought into school the week of the **10th February** to be shared with your class and teacher. If you complete any homework on Purple Mash, there will be a class folder labelled 'Spring Homework' for you to save your work in!

As well as this, you will receive a Maths and English task to help you prepare for your SATs and to get you into the habit of doing weekly homework in preparation for secondary school. These tasks will be given out on a Monday and must be handed in by or on the following Monday morning. Remember, the weekly tasks are written in your Reading Record for you to remember. The first task will be set on Monday 13th January.

Don't forget, as part of your homework, you should also be practising the Statutory Spellings for Y3/4 and Y5/6 as well as practising your times tables.

Finally, please remember to read at home every night. Please tell us about the book you are reading by writing in your reading record. We would like to see at least 4 entries in your reading record weekly. We will check your reading records every Monday!
