The Curriculum

<u>English</u>

In English, the children will start the term by writing a narrative all about shadows. During this, they will be focusing on how to use speech marks correctly. Next, they will be writing part of a myth based on the Greek tale of 'Theseus and the Minotaur'.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths the children will be extending their knowledge of fractions, including looking at fractions of amounts, adding and subtracting fractions and recognising equivalences. After this, we will move on to looking at money, understanding pounds and pence, converting pounds and pence, adding and subtracting money and giving change.

Other Curriculum Subjects.

In **Science** the children will be learning about plants. The children will be exploring the different parts of a plant and their purpose, investigating what a plant needs to survive and looking at the life cycle of a plant.

In **History** the children will be learning about the Iron Age. As part of this, the children will learn how artefacts help us understand the lives of people from the past. They will also look at how life of people changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. In **R.E** the children will be learning about the lives and beliefs of a Sikh, including Sikh celebrations.

In **Computing** they will be learning how to use branching databases using Purplemash. They will then move on to learning how to use simulations.

In Art the children will be learning how to create ancient scrolls.

- In Music the children will be learning how to use tunned percussion.
- In P.E the children will learn how to play tennis and take part in athletics.
