The Curriculum

English

In English, the children will start the term by writing a non-fiction text about skeletons and muscles, applying their knowledge of the organisational features of non-fiction texts. The children will then be writing their own colour collector poem, using the sound collector by Robert McGlough for inspiration and guidance. They will be developing their knowledge of rhyming words and patterns further.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, children will be learning the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. They will be developing their measuring skills, focusing on drawing lines and shapes accurately. The children will also be learning about turns and angles followed by comparing angles. Finally, the children will be looking at statistics, creating and interpreting graphs. Throughout the half term the children will also be going over the 2,3,4,5 and 8 times tables.

Other Curriculum Subjects.

In **Science** the children will be learning about skeletons and muscles. They will learn the purpose of the skeletal system in animals and humans as well as how the muscular system works.

In **Geography** the children will be learning about Mega cities. This will include studying Milton Keynes and Brasilia and understanding why Milton Keynes is a fast-growing city.

In **R**.**E** the children will be learning about Hinduism.

In **Computing** they will continue to look at simulations before moving on to learning about the skills of presentation.

In **D**.**T** the children will be looking at packaging and the nets which are used to make these. The children will then design and create their own packaging.

In **music** the children will be learning to play the recorder.

In P.E the children will learn various skills in athletic lessons.

<u>Reading</u>

Your children have one reading for pleasure book which they have selected from the classroom as well as one library book. Please take the time to hear your child read 5 times a week and record this in the reading record book.

<u>Times tables</u>

Knowing their times tables fluently will help your child in many different areas of mathematics. By the end of Year 3 children are expected to know off by heart their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables.
